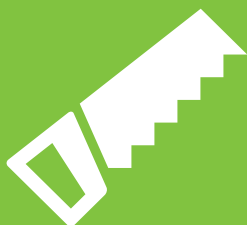

High performance homes incentives

Eligibility	Efficiency	Incentive amount per home
PSE electric space and water heat	20% above WSEC (4-Star BuiltGreen or equivalent)	\$1,500
PSE electric space and water heat	30% above WSEC (5-Star BuiltGreen or equivalent)	\$2,000
PSE gas space and water heat; pse electric	20% above WSEC (4-Star BuiltGreen or equivalent)	\$1,500
PSE gas space and water heat; pse electric	30% above WSEC (5-Star BuiltGreen or equivalent)	\$2,000
PSE gas space and water heat; other non-pse electric	20% above WSEC (4-Star BuiltGreen or equivalent)	\$750
PSE gas space and water heat; other non-pse electric	30% above WSEC (4-Star BuiltGreen or equivalent)	\$1,000

PSE offers incentives for new single-family homes

How to qualify

To be eligible for PSE's high performance homes incentives:

- Projects must have three or fewer attached units.
- Projects must be within PSE's electric and/or natural gas service area.
- Projects must be in the design or construction phase with a permit date of January 1, 2018 or later.
- Incentives are only available on projects that exceed local Washington State Energy Code efficiency requirements or standard practice by at least 20 percent.
